This led the MD to call me in. With my help, the survey data were exported from mysql, for each state into individual MS Excel worksheets. Using VBA code, and graphic user interfaces I built an MS Excel-VB driven application to generate data summaries by state, LGA and ward based on selections the user makes (from worksheet based drop menus) within minutes.

Examples of auto-generated reports: Number of Doctors, Nurses, Community Health Extension Workers per facility, per Ward, LGA, State, Region and Nationally. The program would cycle through the main database to extract and summarise relevant numbers for each criterion, then post them in a ready to print multi-page report format.

Just a few mouse clicks needed. This application saved them generating the same reports manually, in a process that would have taken weeks on end. Since 2008, when I did the first job, my mandates have been repeatedly extended (about twice a years), with the client recalling me to include new functions/extensions into the application.

In March 2012, I was given a new mandate to add another layer of automated reporting to the software. <u>This project in particular helped me demonstrate to prospective clients, that my MS Excel solutions are not limited to Financial Reporting.</u>
